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FAQs for National Immunisation Schedule Feature - addition of new Zoster Vaccine

- Q: When does the MOH funding for the Zoster Vaccine begin?**
A: 1st April 2018.
- Q: I've got a patient who's older than 65. Can I give them the funded Zoster Vaccine?**
A: Yes, up until 31 March 2020. A 'catch-up' programme will run for the first two years. During this period, the Zoster vaccine (Zostavax) will be funded for people between the ages of 65 to 80 years inclusive.
Note: From 1 April 2020, only people that are 65 will be eligible.
- Q: Can a patient who isn't in the funded age range receive the Zoster Vaccines?**
A: Yes. A new, **non-funded** Zoster Vaccine, 'Zoster No Claims', is available via the **Single Syringe** icon on the 'Immunisation Schedule' tab and the 'All Immunisations' tab.
